Presenting the prestigious award at the ceremony was the Chief Guest, P Dayaratne, Minister of Food Security. The accolade was a result of extensive pre and final assessments carried out by the Sri Lanka tourism development authority (SLTDA) in partnership with Ind-Expo certification, a joint venture of the Ceylon National Chamber of Industries and the National Chamber of Exporters of Sri Lanka. The programme is supported by the United Nations Industrial Development Organization (UNIDO) and is being implemented in affiliation with the Ministry of Industrial Development.
