After registering for the service by dialing #111#, eZ Cash mobile subscribers can maintain a mobile money account in their mobile phones and conduct various money transactions through these accounts.

Transactions are protected by a subscriber defined PIN number, secured by 3DES authentication and transaction Security protocols. A registered eZ Cash subscriber can load money in to his/her mobile phone at any one of over 10,000 eZ Cash outlets across Sri Lanka.
