For more than seventeen centuries, the Kandy Esala Perahera has stood as Sri Lanka's most revered cultural and religious spectacle.

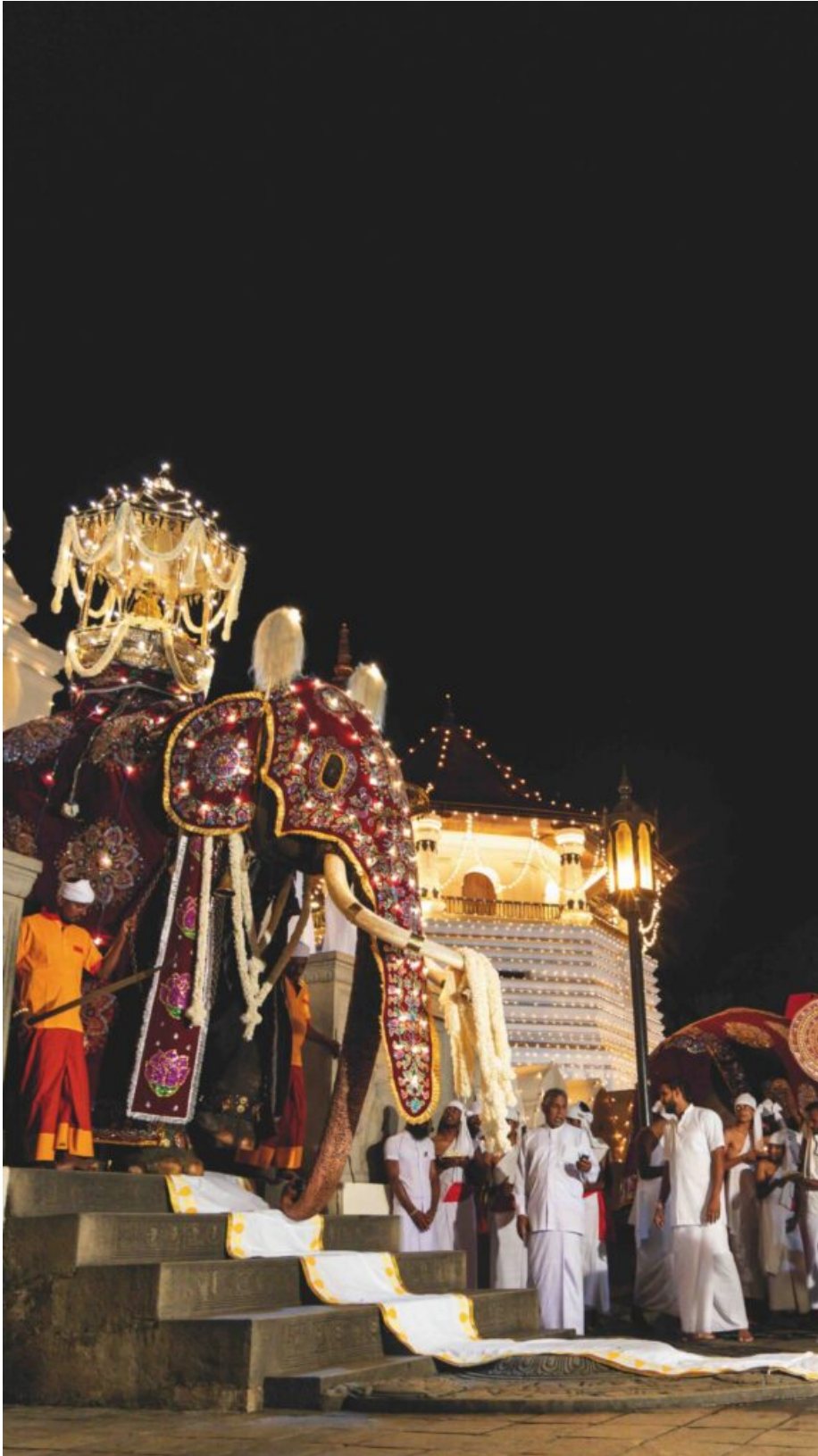
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A rare reflection of the sacred Perahera Karanduwa before Sri Dalada Maligawa captures the timeless grandeur of the Kandy Esala Perahera.

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During the Randoli Perahera, the sacred procession reaches its grandest expression with richly adorned tuskers, carpet runners, royal canopies, and centuries-old tradition.

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The flower-adorned Perahera Karanduwa is the spiritual centerpiece of the Kandy Esala Perahera, carried with the utmost reverence in a tradition.



The Kumbal Perahera heralds the Kandy Esala Perahera as magnificently caparisoned tuskers, accompanied by dancers, drummers, and ceremonial attendants, begin the sacred procession through Kandy.

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An enduring symbol of Sri Lanka's Buddhist heritage, the Kandy Esala Perahera has inspired generations through more than seventeen centuries of sacred ritual, royal tradition, and living cultural artistry. Illuminated by majestic tuskars, rhythmic drummers, graceful Kandyan dancers, and ceremonial fire performers, the procession transforms the historic streets of Kandy into a breathtaking celebration of faith and devotion, preserving one of Asia's most extraordinary living cultural traditions for generations to come.

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A traditional Hevisi drummer fills the streets of Kandy with powerful rhythmic beats, providing the ceremonial heartbeat of the Kandy Esala Perahera and preserving a musical tradition that has echoed through the sacred procession for centuries.

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The Ves dancer, adorned in the sacred Ves costume, represents the pinnacle of Kandyan dance. Rooted in centuries-old ritual traditions, the performance embodies strength, grace, spiritual devotion, and the enduring

cultural heritage of Sri Lanka.

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A radiant temple tusker adorned in a vibrant caparison leads the Devale Perahera, carrying centuries of sacred tradition through the illuminated streets of Kandy as part of the revered Kandy Esala Perahera.

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Reflections shimmer across the tranquil waters surrounding the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic as the sacred Perahera Karanduwa, carried by a magnificently adorned tusker, makes its ceremonial passage. Illuminated against the night sky, this timeless scene embodies the devotion, grandeur, and living traditions of the Perahera.

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The Day Perahera (Dahawal Perahera), departing from the historic Asgiriya Gedige Royal Temple, marks the ceremonial conclusion of the Kandy Esala Perahera. Held in daylight following the Water-Cutting Ceremony, it offers a rare opportunity to witness the sacred procession, accompanied by richly adorned tuskers, traditional dancers, drummers, and ceremonial attendants.
