At the launch, sisters Niroshani Leanage and Neloni Leanage outlined their vision in creating this boutique and new range of designer wear. “Fashion is my passion,” stated Niroshani, explaining how her initial focus was on providing training for young designers through the Lanka Institute of Fashion Technology.
