On the first floor, baskets woven in reeds, vases, wood-carved fruit bowls and other decorative items are available. Paintings are hung on the walls following different art techniques such as abstract and wildlife.

On the second floor, an elegant sofa with a unique coffee table stands as evidence to The Guild's continuing commitment towards furniture where quality combines with novel designs. Both Sudantha and Theekshana collaborate with the customers to create unique interior solutions.
