Some of the immunizations available at Park Hospitals for babies and children are BCG, DTP, OPV, HBV & Hib, Measles, ATD, Rubella, Tetanus Toxoid and Hepatitis for children, among others.

Vaccinations available for adults are many, and among them are Hepatitis A, Typhoid, Japanese Encephalitis, Hepatitis B, Rabies, Tetanus, Diphtheria, Measles, Cholera, Yellow Fever, Influenza and Chicken Pox.
