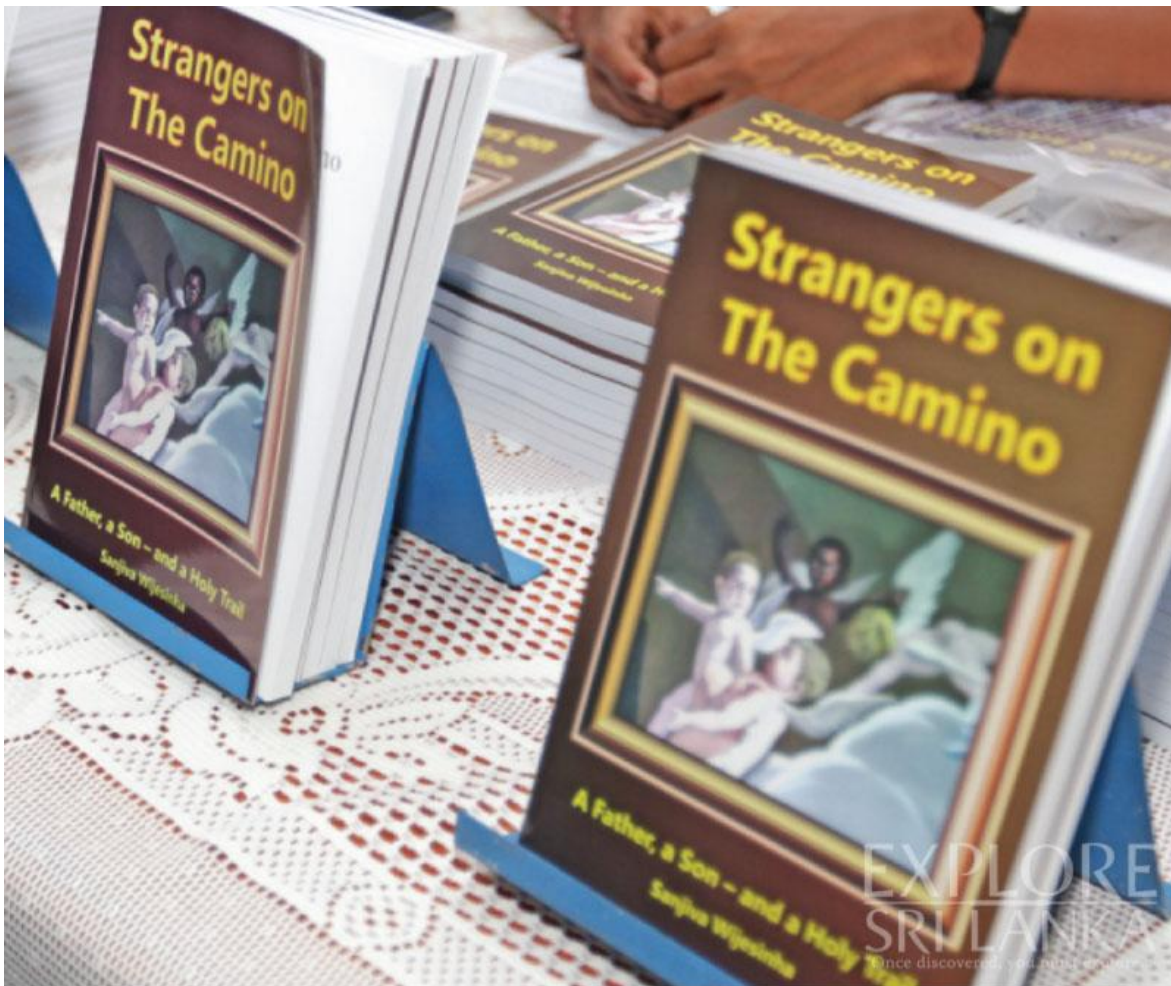


Strangers On The Camino Launched
