The Thaproban Pavilion Resort and Spa nestled along the Unawatuna Beach in Galle stands out as a unique property of the Thambapanni Leisure Group offering a distinctive experience of luxury and tranquillity to travellers.

Overlooking the Galle Fort, the architecture of the building is entirely based on giving the guests a feeling of the bygone Dutch era.
