Her collection also truly shines in the way she weaves Sri Lankan heritage into modern living. Delicate touches of beeralu lace and batik transform her creations into exquisite pieces of home décor. She also experiments with handloom textiles, beloved by customers seeking authentic Sri Lankan artistry, especially those travelling abroad. As she incorporates Sri Lanka's traditional craft elements into her collection, it boosts the livelihoods of local artisans, makes their crafts relevant for the times, and ensures their longevity.

Everything is a curated selection. At the store, one immediately notices the care and thought Naushaly invests in selecting designs, colors, and fabrics.
