In Pāli, saṅkhārā speaks of “formations” — the countless volitional stirrings of the mind, layered moment by moment from the time of birth. Thoughts, fleeting and weighty, conscious and unconscious, accumulate and dissolve, leaving traces upon the self. This work seeks to make visible what is otherwise intangible. The simplified figure embodies life itself — our endless striving toward contentment, our adornment with achievements, and our quiet recognition that peace remains elusive. The figure entwines with an abstracted vessel, symbolizing the mind's formations. Though these vessels seem solid, they hold only emptiness. When the layers of thought are stripped away, what remains is śūnyatā — the luminous emptiness at the heart of being. This collection is an offering: a meditation on becoming, seeking, and the profound stillness discovered within nothingness.

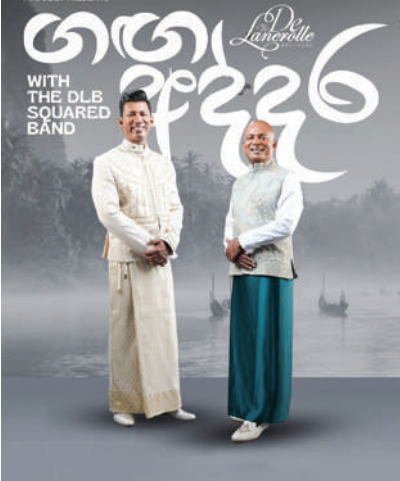
The Nutcracker
