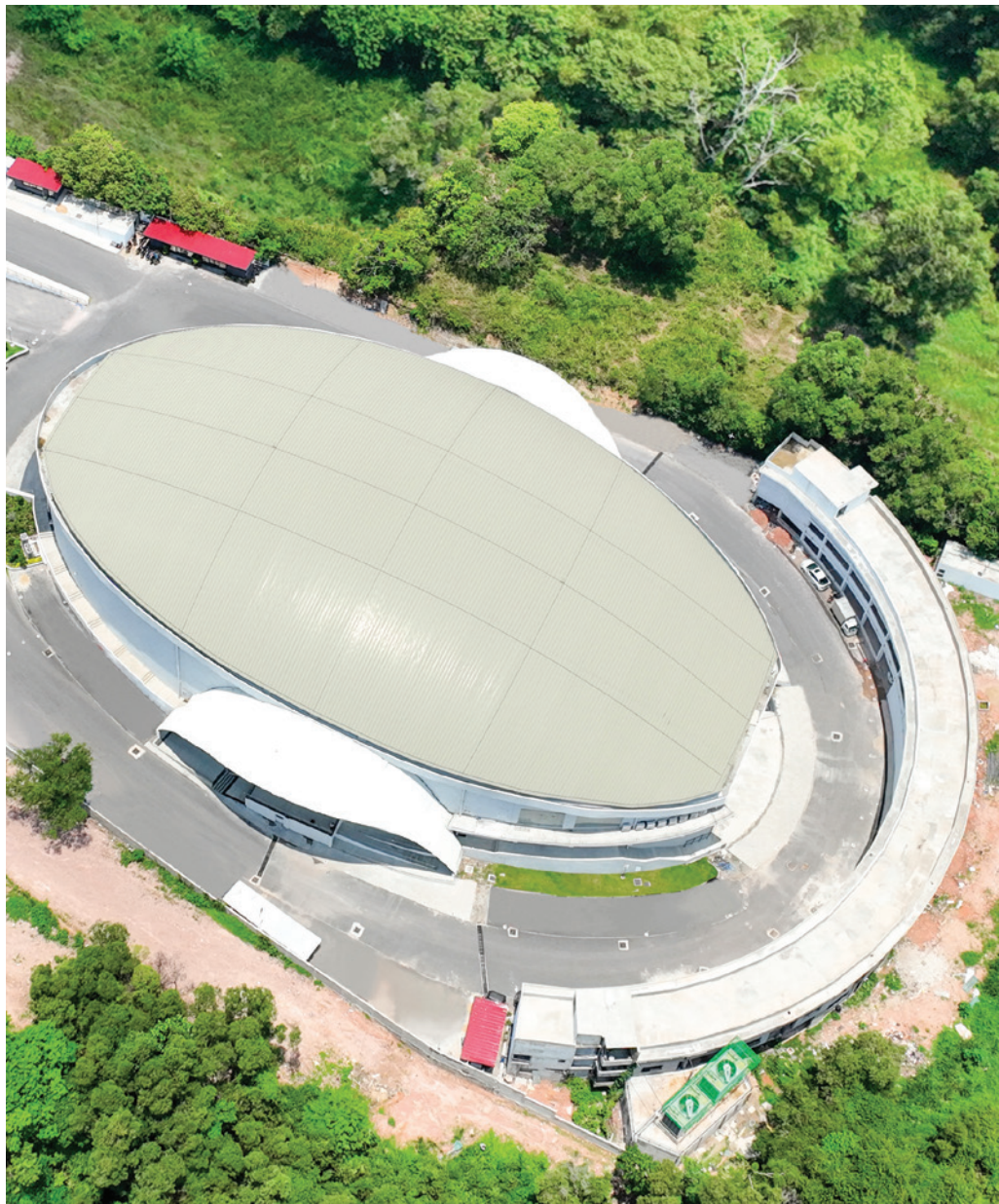

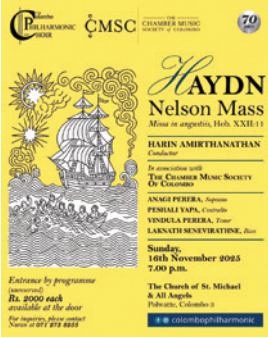

#### ARUGAMBAY WHERE TO GO

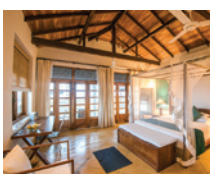
