







Ahangama

Surfing spots
A popular surf destination on Sri Lanka's south coast, known for its consistent reef breaks and variety of waves suited to intermediate and advanced surfers, with a few spots friendly to confident beginners. Set against palm-lined beaches and iconic stilt fishermen, Ahangama offers powerful waves, uncrowded lineups, and a relaxed surf-town vibe that appeals to surfers seeking both quality breaks and coastal charm.

ARUGAMBAY

WHERE TO GO
Arugambay, a scenic southeastern coastal town and one of Asia's top travel spots, offers rich culture, abundant wildlife, and vibrant dining along its sunset-lit Main Road. Nearby national parks provide sightings of elephants, leopards, and diverse birds.

Surfing spots

Arugambay Main Point
The most popular and iconic surf break in Arugam Bay, Sri Lanka. Renowned for its consistent, powerful waves, it attracts surfers from around the world. The waves here are typically large, fast, and strong, making the spot best suited for experienced surfers who are comfortable handling bigger swells and longer rides.

Whisky Point, Pottuvil

A friendly and scenic surf spot near Pottuvil, known for its gentle whitecaps that make it ideal for beginners and learners. The waves are more forgiving, allowing newcomers to practice and build confidence, while experienced surfers also visit to enjoy the point's playful swells and smooth, swirling rides.

Peanut Farm Point

A tranquil and picturesque surf spot near Arugambay, where a rustic shrub forest and a glassy lagoon frame the sandy beach. The natural setting gives the area a remote, untouched feel, making it a favorite among surfers and nature lovers who enjoy a quieter atmosphere alongside consistent waves.

Pottuvil Point

Known for its gnarly, elusive waves that appear only at the right moments, often peaking during July and August. For much of the season, the break remains flat, but when conditions align, surfers quickly gather to chase the rare swells. The waves that rise here can be powerful and mammoth, making this point strictly the domain of experienced riders willing to take on its challenging conditions.

Panama Point

A lesser-known and uncrowded surf spot near Arugambay, appreciated for its occasional left-hand breaks. When the conditions line up, these waves are especially enjoyable for goofy-foot surfers, offering smooth rides in a quieter, more laid-back setting compared to the main points in the area.

Panagala Point

Also known as Secret Point, it is a newly discovered surf break on Sri Lanka's Eastern Coast. Tucked away beyond a rustic, rural landscape, reaching this spot is an adventure in itself, with the scenic drive adding to its charm. Its off-the-beaten-path location keeps it quiet and uncrowded, making Panagala Point a rewarding find for surfers seeking both waves and a sense of exploration.
